

## Q1 Are you registered to vote in the United States?





#### Q2 Which best describes your freethought views?





## Q3 What is your political affiliation?





## Q4 What is the most dangerous threat to the separation of church and state?





#### Q5 Why are so few Atheists in elected office?








#### Q8 How frequently do you vote?







## Q9 What is your age?





## Q10 What is your gender?





# Q11 Which category of race, ethnicity or origin describes you? (Select all that apply.)


